PACE supports our elderly community so they can remain at home by providing needed medical support and social services.

COST

PACE services are sponsored by Medicare and Medicaid. Cost is based on income, and can be FREE or a single monthly payment.

As a PACE participant, all health care services are provided or arranged by your PACE team (except for emergency services).
A participant may be fully liable for the cost of medical services made without prior authorization.
