Health Head to Toe

The health team works with you to create a head-to-toe personalized plan. We take a holistic approach and look at emotional, medical, social, or spiritual needs and believe this helps people to live a vibrant life in their home and community. You have access to:

- Medical doctors and nurses
- Social worker
- Therapy
- Dietician
- Activities and Recreation
- Pharmacy Services

PACE participants might have to pay for any services that aren't authorized or covered by the PACE program agreement.



Social Center

Our College Road campus offers a place for people to come together, enjoy activities and to socialize with other people. The recreation team manages a monthly schedule and incorporates exercise, music, art as well as outside trips throughout the Wilmington area. Elderhaus also works with outside organizations to bring other experiences for people to enjoy.



Transportation

As a member of Elderhaus PACE, you are driven to and from medical appointments and from your home to our Social Center on College Road. This allows us to connect people to services without the burden of planning a trip or locating someone to drive you.



(in) Home Care

Our in-home care services can be non-medical for things like bathing and dressing or light housekeeping or medical where a nurse or therapy of the social worker visit to check on a medical condition. Your head-to-toe plan outlines what services will be provided as a support to help you live at home safely and most important, to enjoy a vibrant life.

Eligibility for Elderhaus services

There are four things that make someone eligible for our services: age, living within our coverage area, the ability to live safely in the community and having any medical conditions that benefits from regular monitoring. Consider making a visit to meet with a team member to learn about Elderhaus PACE!

- 55 years and older
- A resident of New Hanover County or Brunswick County (specific zip codes apply)
- Able to live safely in your home and community
- Have medical conditions that can be managed at home and that will support you with regular monitoring
